

## Adding a Stroke or Keyline

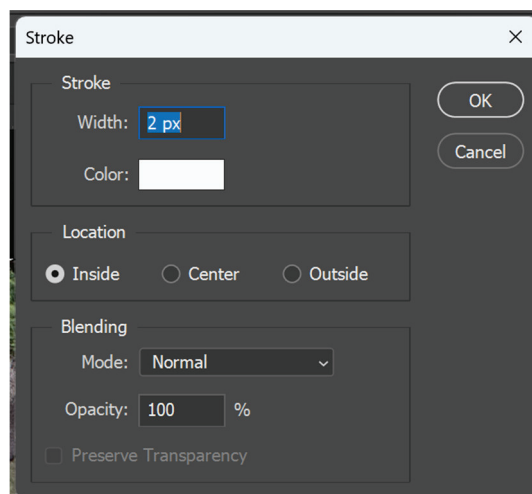
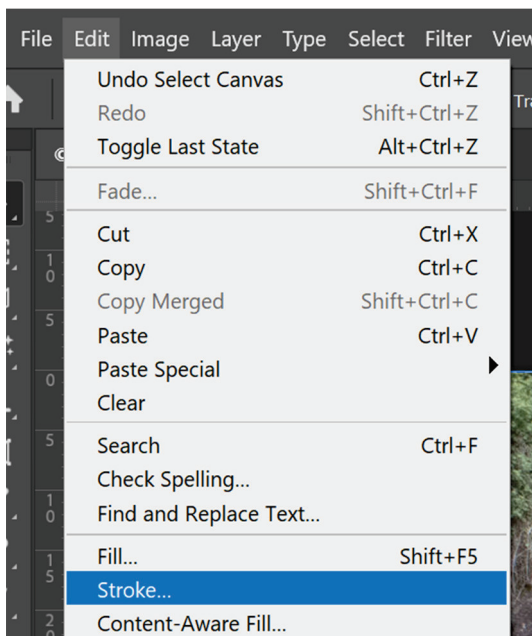
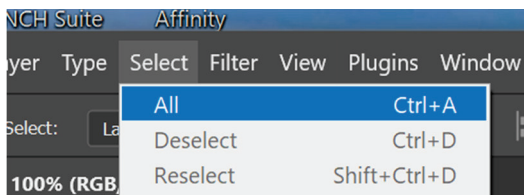
Both Photoshop and Elements have a simple way to add a thin line to the edge of an image, especially useful for adding a light keyline to a pdf or a keyline to an image for print. It is the last thing to do after the image has been edited, resized and, if needed, had a final sharpening.

Simply **Select | All** (or **Ctrl+A**) then **Edit | Stroke**. Select **2px** (enough for a pdf), **white** (can use an alternative colour if desired) and **Inside**. Press **OK** and **Select | Deselect (Ctrl+D)**.

Then you can sav as a jpeg as normal.
